

ETNA2020 website terms and conditions of use

Applicable between ETNA2020 and end users/event attendants (“You”)

1. Introduction and scope of application

When you register for an event on the website you agree to the terms and conditions set out below. In case there are additional event organisers, you also agree to related Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree to the Terms and Conditions, you may not register for an event on this website.

ETNA2020 events are free of charge. However, if they are organized in conjunction with and/or in the context of other events, the latter may require the payment of a participation fee. In this case, you will refer to the Terms and Conditions as well as the payment procedures of the related website.

During the registration process personal data will be collected and further processed for the purposes detailed hereafter by Instytut Podstawowych Problemów Techniki Polskiej Akademii Nauk (IPPT PAN). Upon demand, IPPT PAN can modify or delete personal data.

2. Use of data and data protection

2.1 What personal information do we collect/process and for which purpose?

2.1.1 Data we collect

Contact data (name, organisation name, position, address, contact details, phone, email, password,...). You are advised not to insert any confidential information.

Users’ business-related data, e.g. Organisation description, Business-, Project- or Research proposals (I am offering...), along with contact data, are also collected by ETNA2020 for the purpose of profiles’ promotion in the context of the project networking activities.

The collection of Partner searches-related data refers to Idealist Terms and Conditions.

2.1.2 Data we publish

ETNA 2020 will not publish event participants’ contact data identified above. However, when ETNA 2020 is organizing or supporting the organization of Brokerage or Networking events, managed by third parties on their related website, catalogs of organisations’ business-related data, e.g. Organisation description, Business-, Project- or Research proposals (I am offering ...), along with contact data, may be published on the ETNA2020 website to support the matchmaking process.

Users’ business-related data, e.g. Organisation description, Business-, Project- or Research proposals (I am offering ...), along with contact data, are published for the purpose of profiles’ promotion under ‘Partner Profiles’ of the ETNA2020 website in the context of the project networking activities.

The publishing of Partner searches-related data refers to Idealist Terms and Conditions.

2.1.3 Purpose

Contact data provided are used to facilitate the event management for the event organisers. The ‘Partner Profiles’-related data are used for facilitating the matchmaking process.

2.2 Who has access to your data?

2.2.1 General remarks on visibility

The ‘Partner Profiles’-related data are visible to initiate and facilitate the matchmaking process. ETNA 2020 consortium may use your contact data to assist you prior, during and after an event, if required.

2.2.2 Event organizer

ETNA 2020 consortium, as event organizer, have access to all data you provided (password excepted) and can download your data in Excel format to manage registration lists, name tag, etc.

2.2.3 How long do we keep your data?

Data are stored indefinitely and are deleted according to operator maintenance schedule.

2.3 Editing and deleting data

2.3.1 Inserting

During the events registration process you are requested to insert data as indicated in the registration forms. Inserted data must be correct and must not violate any other person(s) and/or organisation(s) rights.

3. Changing terms of use

ETNA 2020 retains the right to change these terms of use at any time. You will be notified about an upcoming change prior to its effective date. If you do not object within 2 weeks from receipt of notification the change of the terms of use becomes effective. Notification will take place on the ETNA 2020 website. You are therefore recommended to regularly check the terms section on the ETNA 2020 website for updates.

4. Website content

4.1 Website content

The static pages of the website (Home, Contact, Agenda ...) are inserted and edited by IPPT PAN. ETNA 2020 website may contain links to third party websites. For these external website ETNA 2020 is not liable.

4.2 Participant's profiles

Participant's profiles are inserted by the users. ETNA 2020 checks the appropriateness of the data inserted under the 'Partner Profiles' section of the website.

5. Copyright

The website itself, the graphics, images, pdfs and similar content are protected by Copyright Law. It is therefore not allowed to edit, copy or publish such content without the explicit consent of ETNA 2020 or the mentioned sole owner of the copyright. You will also not undertake any technical action that violates the copyright of ETNA 2020 or the mentioned copyright owner.

You agree that ETNA 2020 can use content published by you irrevocably for the purposes described in these Terms. You are solely liable for the published content and any damages resulting from breach of rights of third parties (especially copyright). You will hold harmless ETNA 2020 and the event organizer in this respect.

6. Technical information

6.1 Data security

ETNA 2020 undertakes various technical measures in accordance with data protection law to prevent abuse from outside. This includes measures such as firewalls, anti-hacking programs and other security measures. In the very unlikely case that data are lost, ETNA 2020 excludes liability for deleted files or any lost data.

6.2 Disorders of online access

ETNA 2020 cannot guarantee constant accessibility or functionality of the website. ETNA 2020 is not liable for any defects that may exist or for any costs, losses of profit, losses of data or consequential losses arising from your use of or inability to access the Website as well as from incorrect information.

6.3 Cookies

To extend the functionality of our website and to make the use of the website more comfortable, ETNA 2020 uses "cookies". Data are stored on your computer when visiting our website to make login and navigation more comfortable. This website collects logs and statistics to provide usage information for website operator. All data is stored on IPPT PAN servers. Data are stored indefinitely and are deleted according to operator maintenance schedule.

6.5 Where do we store data?

The collected data, business profiles (if inserted) and all other event related information is stored on the servers of IPPT PAN. Our servers are located in Krzywickiego 34 Street, Warsaw, Poland.

7. Your obligations and consent

You hereby agree that you will only use the Website in accordance with these Terms and/or additional Terms.

You are responsible for any content provided by you, which is published on this website.

You agree to indemnify ETNA 2020 consortium on demand immediately for any losses or damages, including where necessary any legal, administrative or technical charges, that may arise from misuse.

When you register to an event organized by ETNA 2020, the latter uses your contact data to initiate mailings to confirm your participation, follow up, ask for feedback, exc..
